I understand there will be other CONs which the Republic hopes to attend and once determined, we will be advising you.

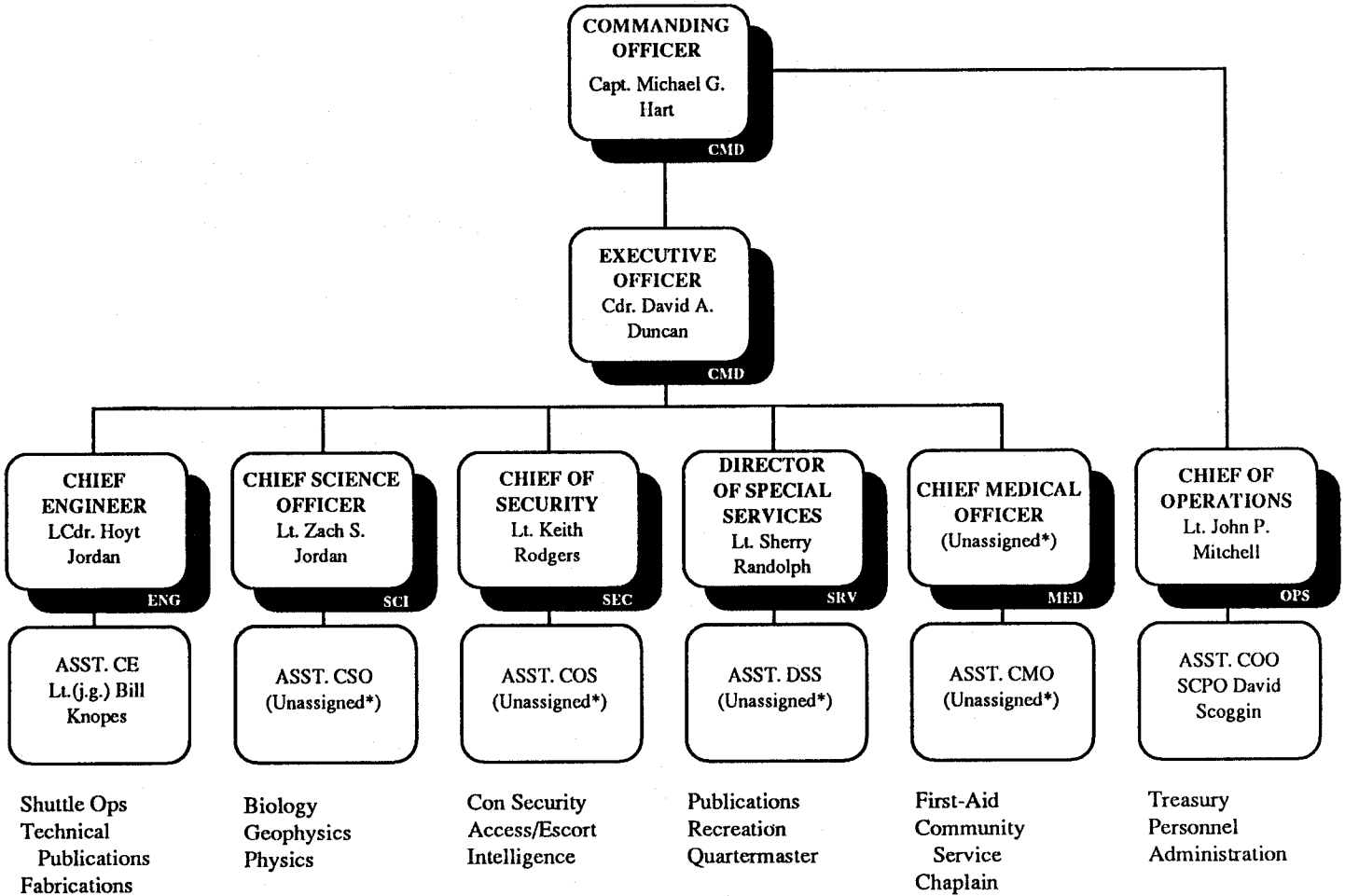

Organization Chart



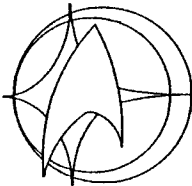
